

The Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences (UPWr) plans to carry out a project entitled "Excellence in clinical sciences –a project to improve the clinical competences of students of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the UPWr" financed by the National Agency for Academic Exchange under the Program SPINAKER - Intensive International Education Programs.

The plan provides for the creation of three modules dedicated to individual species of animals, led by academic teachers who are also certified specialists (Diplomates) in a specific clinical field.

We plan to conduct three modules, 50 teaching hours each, of which about 2/3 hours will be conducted in the form of online lectures, and the remaining number of hours in the form of practical workshops with the use of medical equipment and live animals.

Three programs will be offered to summer school participants:

IMPK Diseases of production animals.

IMPK Diseases of horses.

IMPK Diseases of dogs and cats.

Project title: „Excellence in clinical sciences –a project to improve the clinical competences of students of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine of the UPWr“.

Beneficiaries: foreign students studying at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences in the field of veterinary medicine (English Division), as well as Erasmus + / CEEPUS scholarship holders. It is also planned to recruit students from other foreign veterinary departments for the project.

Project objectives: increasing the clinical competencies of students, acquiring a specific resource of knowledge and practical skills, increasing awareness and perception of Poland as a country with a high level of education culture, attractive for future and current students.

Deadline for recruitment: February 2022.
