 agreement may be terminated by either party. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of
 at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing
 commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. Neither the European Commission nor the
 National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
