Inter-institutional agreement 2017/18-2020/21 between programme countries



The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme in accordance with the terms of the original signed inter-institutional agreement to which this renewal and all amendments are appended.

They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organisation and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.

Universität Stuttgart (D STUTTGA01) and Uniwersytet Przyrodniczy we Wrocławiu (PL WROCLAW04), hereby agree to renew the inter-institutional agreement in the field(s) of 0532. Earth sciences (Geodesy and Geoinformatics) at the terms stipulated in the original inter-institutional agreement of 2014-17.

This inter-institutional agreement is valid for the duration of 2017/18 – 2020/21, and may be updated or terminated by mutual agreement. In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."
