Previously, an amicable solution must have been attempted, based on good faith and good will criteria, in order to avoid disputes. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of conflict. The Agreement may be terminated by either Party providing sixty (60) days advance written notice to the other Party. In the case of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. The Agreement may be extended or amended by mutual consent of the Parties.

The sending institution, following agreement with the receiving institution, is responsible for providing support to its nominated candidates so that they can have the recommended language skills at the start of the study or teaching period.
